- (2) That alcoholic beverages containing more than 5% alcohol by weight and as described in Section 67-1-5(a) of the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, as 3 Amended, will not be possessed by any person, or sold, kept, or stored in or on the premises in areas that do not allow the sale of such beverages.
- (3) That beer, wine, or alcoholic beverages containing more than 5% alcohol by weight and as described in Section 67-1-5(a) of the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, as Amended, will not be sold or given to be consumed in or upon any licensed premises between the hours of midnight and seven o'clock the following morning or during any time the licensed premises may be required to be closed by municipal ordinance except, however, in areas where the sale of alcoholic beverages is legal under the provisions of the local Alcoholic Beverage Control Law and the hours for selling such alcoholic beverages have been extended beyond midnight for on-premises under Section 67-1-37, the hours for selling beer or light wines are likewise extended in areas where the sale of beer or light wines is legal.
